RESPONSE TO DEFENSE DEMAND FOR SEARCH
AND SEIZURE, CONFIDENTIAL INFORMANT

1. A search of defendant's residence was conducted pursuant to his written consent thereto, a copy of which is hereto attached.

These include, but are not limited to, clothing, shoes, pistols, a shoulder holster, ammunition and numerous other tangible things. Certain documents were obtained, including life insurance policies or copies thereof, and some business records, copies of which are hereto attached.
3. The State has no material information which has been provided by a confidential informant.
4. There has been no electronic surveillance, or wire-tapping of the accused or of the premises of the accused.
